



Xaverian College Provider Access Policy

Introduction

This policy statement sets out the college arrangements for managing the access of provider to students at the college for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education and training offer. This complies with the college legal obligations under section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Pupil entitlement

All pupils in year 12-13 are entitled:

to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.

To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, included technical education and apprenticeships through pastoral discussions, options events, lunch time presentations, post 18 fairs

To understand how to make application for the full range of academic and technical courses.
